




Looking back as the year draws to a close, all of us at SCIPS would like to take this opportunity to thank you - our members and friends - for your amazing support in 2022.

South Staffs Water

Services include;

- Assure Tarriff which offers a 60% reduction in year 1 and a 40% reduction in year 2 (for households with income under £19k)
- Water Sure - a national scheme to cap water charges for people on a meter
- Priority services register
- Water meters
- Free water saving kits

15 WAYS TO SAVE



Make five simple changes to the way you use energy at home.

Turn the heating down by 1 degree **£229**

Air dry laundry when possible **£77**

Avoid standby and unplug gadgets **£66**

Switch lights off in unoccupied rooms **£31**

Always fully load the washing machine **£11**



Make five simple changes to the way you heat water at home.

Set your hot water tap temperature to 50°C **£115**

Keep showers to 4 mins maximum **£112**

Use a plug when washing up **£71**

Swap one bath per week for a 4 min shower **£26**

Wash laundry at 30°C instead of 40/60°C **£20**



Make five simple changes to the way you cook at home.

Use the most efficient cooking appliance **£202**

Batch cook when possible **£112**

Use the right size pan with a lid **£51**

Simmer rather than boil **£48**

Avoid over-filling the kettle **£13**



Please note that the last day our offices will be open prior to Christmas is Thursday 22nd December 2022.


