Launching the Digi-Comm Good Practice Guide

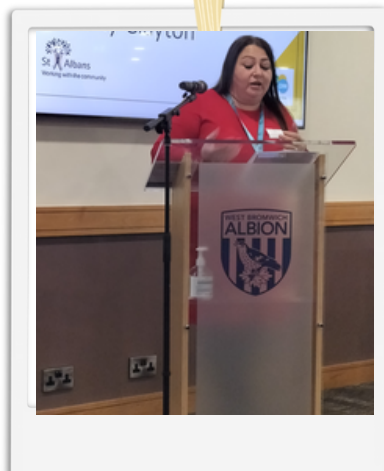

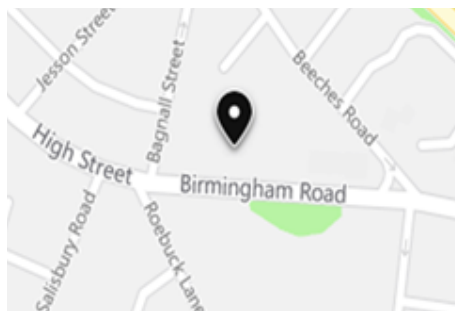
